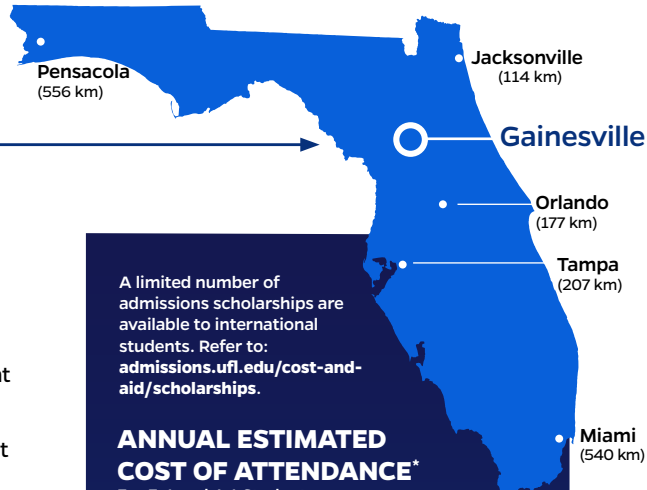

HOW TO APPLY

The admissions process is designed to consider all aspects of an applicant's academic record and personal experiences.

1. Complete the online application by November 1 at admissions.ufl.edu.
2. Submit the \$30 application fee using a valid credit card in U.S. funds.
3. Official high school transcripts in both native language and English translation, if applicable.
4. Official course-by-course report completed by a credential evaluation agency (recommended but not required).
5. Official ACT or SAT scores sent directly from the testing center. SAT: 5812; ACT: 0758.
6. Applicants whose native language is not English are encouraged to submit a TOEFL (5812), IELTS or Doulingo test score for demonstrated English proficiency. Score reports must be sent directly from the testing agency.
