


ICHETUCKNEE RIVER — Kayak, canoe, tube or snorkel down this crystal river.

APPLYING TO UF

English Proficiency

Applicants whose native language is not English are encouraged to submit a TOEFL (5812), IELTS or MELAB test score for demonstrated English proficiency. Score reports must be sent directly from the testing agency.

Transcripts

Submit your official secondary school transcripts in the native language and official word-for-word English translation. At least three years of coursework, including courses in progress, are required. Electronic uploads will be temporarily accepted for admission review through the application status page.

Submit Test Scores

Submit official SAT or ACT scores directly from the testing agency. (SAT 2 scores are not required for admission). School Code for SAT: 5812, ACT: 0758.

Credential Evaluations

If your secondary curriculum does not follow the U.S. pattern, an official NACES (www.naces.org) approved course-by-course evaluation of your transcripts with GPA calculation is highly recommended.
